Dr. Jeremy Whitlock is a Past President of the CNS, Co-Chair of the CNS Education & Communication Committee, and a member of the CNS Chalk River Branch. He has been a CNS member since 1988 when he joined as a student at McMaster University.

He is currently the Manager of Non-Proliferation and Safeguards at Atomic Energy of Canada Limited, with responsibility for ensuring that reactor design at AECL meets international obligations on nuclear weapons non-proliferation.
