Dr. Murray J. Stewart became Executive Director of *World Energy Congress - MONTREAL 2010* in November, 2006.

From 2004 through 2006 he was President of the Energy Council of Canada, the Member Committee of the World Energy Council.

Dr. Stewart has held a variety of positions, through-out a career spanning 36 years, in government and industry. He started his professional career with the federal Department of Energy, Mines and Resources in Ottawa, in metallurgical research, project management and ultimately policy development.

Experience as a Vice President at General Electric Canada and as President & CEO of James Howden North America led to the creation of Stewart Advantage Consultants Inc., focussed on the energy industry. He was President & CEO of ITER Canada, established in 1997, with members from industry, governments, labour and universities, committed to hosting the ITER fusion energy project in Canada.

He is a registered Professional Engineer (Mechanical) with a Ph.D. in Metallurgical Engineering from the University of British Columbia; a Director of the Energy Council of Canada, and the Canadian Nuclear Society; and a member of the American Society for Metals, Canadian Institute of Mining and Metallurgy, Professional Engineers Ontario, and the Ontario Society of Professional Engineers.
